Supporting Each Other's Passions

Objective: Examining Passion to Inspire Learning

Estimated Time: 15 Minutes

Materials: Blank paper

Purpose: To support educators align passion to education

Staff Discussion and Activity:

Have teachers fold their papers into thirds. Label the boxes 1, 2, and 3.

1. Write a list all of the things in your life you are passionate about. How can you infuse your passion into your teaching?
2. Share your list with your colleagues and investigate what they are passionate about. Allow yourself to be inspired by your peers
3. Think about what students in your class are passionate about and think about ways to integrate them into your lessons.

Let passion inspire your teaching:

- Find a colleague that is passionate about something and inquire about what they are passionate about. Allow their passion to inspire you. See what happens.
- Teach a lesson about something you are passionate about. Share your passion with students. See what happens.
- Ask students what they are passionate about and let them do a project that reflects that passion. Passion Based Learning; See what happens.
